- 1. Artwork and Photographs of any theme will be accepted.**
- 2. Entry Deadline is January 20th at 5pm.**
3. Up to two entries per adult will be accepted. Students, 18 and under may enter one entry free of charge.
4. Flat entries must be framed, mounted to board or canvas, and have a wire, or other mechanism for hanging. Loose paper will not be accepted.
5. Sculptures cannot exceed 32 inches in height or width.
6. You must provide both copies of the form below for EACH entry. If you have two entries, please fill out the form 4 times.
7. Entries may be of any medium the artist chooses, but may not include materials that may quickly degrade while being shown.
8. The Museum reserves the right to refuse work which it deems inappropriate.

Adult Fee is \$15 per entry (limit 2). No charge for 18 and under (limit one). For purposes of this competition, a professional artist is defined as someone who has sold more than 3 pieces. (4 or more)

CATEGORIES: Adult Professional Art, Adult Nonprofessional Art, Adult Photography

Student Division – Age 15 to 18, Youth Division – 14 and under

Teens Division, and Youth Division can be any medium **including** photography. Teens may choose to pay the \$15 entry fee and enter an Adult Division. Cash prizes will be awarded for all categories. Photographic entries by Teens and Youth will be judged against other artwork.

The award ceremony will be held on February 3rd at the Museum of the Gulf Coast, and will include light snacks and refreshments.

Your entry will hang in the Dunn Gallery and will be available for viewing during operating hours for the duration of the exhibit. All entries must remain with the museum through the duration of the exhibit.

Artists may sell their work. The Museum keeps a 15% commission. Artists will be paid via check.

Please make sure you have entered an email address! Email is how we will communicate with entrants.

The Museum of the Gulf Coast will not accept responsibility for lost or damaged entries. The utmost care will be taken with all entries.

Entries not picked up by the retrieval period of April 17th - 28th will become the property of The Museum of the Gulf Coast.
